

## LAURENTIDE MEN'S DAY 2020

There are many changes to this years mens night due to COVID 19 and the social distancing rules that must apply. Fortunately golf is one the sports we can still play and hopefully we can make it thrive this year as folks are looking for something to get out of the house and do. As such, we are happy to announce that the Laurentide G.C Men's night 2020 will happen. The following format has been adapted:

- Golfers will book their tee times throughout the day, every **Wednesday**. Rounds can be completed any time on the Wednesday but score cards need to be into the pro shop no later than 8 pm Wednesday.
- Laurentide has graciously given us a special rate of play for any guests. You must declare that your participating to get the rate and you must turn in score cards to pro shop after your round.
  - 25\$ to play 18 or 20\$ to play 9 // Members do not pay green fee
  - All golfers pay \$5 (enters you into birdie hole, closet to the pin, longest putt drawings)
  - Carts are a separate fee if you choose to ride
- Only 9 holes will be counted for the Men's night but your group can continue to play the rest of the 18 if you choose to. The front 9 or back 9 will be determined at the club house and it will change week to week.
- All scores will be individual stroke play and score cards signed by two members of the group.
- Each golfer who participates will have their name entered once per event to be drawn for a monthly prize donated from our top sponsors. So if you play in 4 x mens nights your name will be entered 4 times. This encourages you to come back and play more than once. The prize will be displayed throughout the month with signage in the club house and will be either a club, bag or something related to golf.
- Each weekly event, there will be a small prize given to the best score of the flight (A,B,C), closest to the pin and longest putt.
- Winners will be announced on [Laurentides Facebook page](#) and names posted on whiteboard in club house.
